During 2003-2004 Neaimé got signed as one of five songwriters in top international producer Jorgen Elofsson's team (Britney Spears, Westlife, Kelly Clarkson etc). In the spring of 2004, Neaimé landed one of her songs on the soundtrack of the Swedish movie Language of Love.

Her debut album Livin' will be released on her own record label Future Records in early spring 2006. The album will be distributed by Music Master in the Middle East.

5 Her first single "Color of Love", which is currently playing on several radio stations in Lebanon and the Middle East, has started to get recognition in the region.


SHOW YOUR BONES
